The Tree of Life - Exhibition Timeline



January-April 2024

- Recruit artists to participate in the exhibition. Look for opportunities to collaborate with your local congregation/aged care facility/school. You may like to include Christian artists in your wider community.
- □ Consider having a "Getting Started" morning, afternoon or lesson using the materials provided in the first Resource Pack. Look at the bible texts and share ideas and techniques.
- □ You may like to join our LCA Visual Arts Facebook group to share your works in progress.
- □ Confirm your venue and determine what hours your exhibition will be open.
- Decide whether you will have an entry fee, and where the proceeds will go.
- Decide if the artworks will be on sale, and how you will manage any sales.
- If you are in South Australia, consider registering for SALA (the South Australian Living Artists Festival). Registrations for the 2024 SALA Festival will open Wednesday, 1 March 2024. <u>https://www.salafestival.com/participation/</u>
- By 31 May 2024 complete the Exhibition Registration Form attached, or <u>at this link</u>.

June 2024

- □ Start creating if you haven't already begun! Some groups hold making workshops. These are especially useful if you have collaborative projects.
- □ Plan your launch event how will you kick off your exhibition?

July 2024

- By 11 July write a short publicity blurb and gather 2-3 images of artworks which will feature in your exhibition. Email them to Jan Kaesler <u>kaeslerjan@gmail.com</u> for LCANZ publicity and use them to create your local publicity resources. Poster templates are available on the <u>Visual Arts</u> <u>website</u>.
- □ Check in with your artists and confirm the number of artworks to display, and their size. Let them know when and where they should deliver their work.
- □ Start planning how you will display the artworks
- D Publicize your exhibition as widely as you can in your local community
- □ Invite people to your launch event
- Organise a team of people to help you set up
